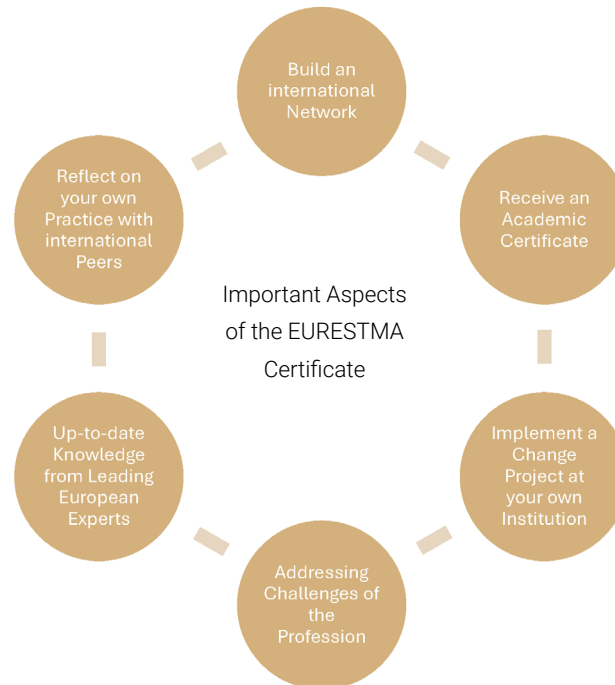

Offered by top academic institutions, this unique certificate program optimizes your learning experience through a combination of flexible online sessions, self-study, and two immersive on-site weeks (3.5 days each) – one in Osnabrück, Germany, and one in Brussels, Belgium. This hybrid approach minimizes your travel costs while maximizing face-to-face interaction, which is essential for effective networking. On-site weeks are strategically designed to foster deep connections and provide invaluable exposure to key research management institutions and policymakers in Brussels. Network with professionals, gain cutting-edge knowledge, and advance your career in an optimal learning environment.

Each year we envisage enrollment of about 20 participants in the program. We are looking for participants who are employed in Research Management position with one to four years of experience. Applicants are expected to participate in both on-site weeks and several online activities and should possess good proficiency in English.

CONTENT

EURESTMA is a comprehensive Research Management program that includes six key topics designed to enhance your expertise and skills in the field. A standout feature of our program is the „Project Action Plan.“ This means that each participant will implement a change project at their own institution during the course of the certificate program. Participants are guided by our experts both during the on-site weeks and through online meetings in between. This hands-on approach not only supports you in applying what you’ve learned but also offers numerous opportunities for peer learning within a diverse group of European Research Managers.

INVESTMENTS

Expect a comprehensive learning journey with two on-site weeks, approximately 10 online meetings, and a hands-on change project at your own institution. This blend of formats is designed to integrate seamlessly with your professional work, making it easier to apply new insights and skills directly in your job.

The program fee is 3950€, which includes study materials, instructors, coaches, lunches, coffee, snacks during on-site weeks, and two evening dinners. After successful completion of the program, you will receive a certificate for 15 ECTS.
